



Wedding Proposal for Minnie and Mickey

Ceremony: The Palace

Reception: The Royal

Date: June 7, 2008

Coordinator/Planner: John Doe

Caterer: Nancy Drew

Color Palette: Espresso brown, ivory, accents of golds, plums, rich tones

Design Theme/Inspiration: Swept away to a Tuscan winery, food to be served family style, incorporation of abundant and rich vegetative elements, including grapes/grapevine, warm, inviting

MINNIE'S BOUQUET

For her bouquet, Minnie may consider one of the following design options:

Option One

An elegant nosegay of garden blooms reminiscent of a lush winery setting. Featuring green viburnum, cream calla lilies with a deep plum throat, cream French tulips, cymbidium orchids in the Bride's choice of green, pale plum or cream with a deep wine throat, the bouquet will evoke a very abundant garden feel while still remaining very formal in its overall design. Pops of white will be added with stephanotis which may be studded with pearl, crystal or glass beads. A foliage such as ivy or smilax may be added for an additional garden touch. The bouquet may be completed with a banding of double-faced satin ribbon in the Bride's choice of color or print. Pearl, glass or crystal beads may be used to anchor the wrapping.

Price: \$156.39

Option Two

An eclectic garden bouquet designed with a concentration on texture and color featuring flowers eponymous with Provencal and Tuscan design. For texture, sunflowers, with petals intact or removed to emphasize the rich chocolate tones of the center, will provide a stunning contrast to groupings of cream French tulips, elegant heirloom roses, green hydrangea, and bouvardia. Rosemary and sage will be interspersed throughout the design, while little posies of French lavender will offer a heady fragrance and beautiful color and texture. Loops of grapevine will bring an elegant rusticity to the bouquet design. Supple grapevine may also be used as a banding on the stems of the bouquet.

Price: \$181.63

Option Three

An explosive clutch bouquet featuring a vivid study in shades of cream, green, plum, and espresso. Tulips, bouvardia, velvety chocolate cosmos, hypericum berries, calla lilies, hanging green amaranthus, rosemary, lavender, spray roses, and green hydrangea will come together in a truly colorful and effusive display. Pops of white will be added with fragrant tuberose, while delicate sweet pea, a favorite of the Bride's, will be tucked into the bouquet for color. The bouquet would be finished with simple touches of vibrant green salal leaves and banded with a wrapping of double-faced satin ribbon in Minnie's choice of color.

Price: \$179.81

MICKEY'S BOUTONNIERE

For his boutonniere, Mickey may select one of the following designs which directly correspond to the potential designs of Minnie's bouquet giving the feeling that the boutonniere was hand-picked from her bouquet. The options include:

Option One

A boutonniere designed from a flawless cream calla lily with a deep plum throat rose accented by stephanotis blooms, simple accents of foliage and finished with a banding of satin ribbon used in the dressing of Minnie's bouquet.

Price: \$21.68

Option Two

A boutonniere designed in a composite style from a deep chocolate sunflower center (with petals removed), a banding of grapevine with accents of French lavender, rosemary, and green hydrangea florets. The boutonniere may be finished with a banding of complementary wrapping to Minnie's bouquet.

Price: \$16.80

Option Three

A boutonniere designed in an eclectic garden style featuring chocolate cosmos, green hydrangea florets, interwoven tuberose florets, and a sweet pea spray backed by a flawless vibrant green salal leaf and finished with a banding of complementary double-faced satin ribbon.

Price: \$18.17

BRIDESMAIDS' BOUQUETS

For her honored attendants, Minnie may consider one of the following designs:

Option One

A clutch bouquet blending varied shades of purples, plums, and golds with accents of chocolate featuring mini-callas in a coppery rust tone, purple hydrangea, and green hypericum berry interspersed with fresh rosemary, lavender and variegated sage. The bouquets will be finished with a wrapping of double-faced satin anchored with pearl, crystal or glass beads. A rich stripe or print in a textural dupioni silk incorporating chocolate, purple and golds would add an eclectic touch.

Price: \$73.04

Option Two

A rich color study in intense shades of purples with accents of fresh green, ivory, chocolate. Featuring purple 'Curiosa' roses, green hydrangea, purple campanula, purple lisianthus, ivory astilbe and chocolate cosmos. "Bursts" of purple agapanthus tucked into the bouquet will add movement and color. The bouquet may be finished with simple accents of vibrant green salal leaves. A banding of double-faced satin in the Bride's choice of color may be used to finish the bouquet.

Option Three

Option One

For her honored attendants, the Bride may select garden clutch bouquets fashioned in a relaxed but elegant style blending varied vegetative and floral elements. Purple kale, green hydrangea, deep rust hypericum berries, rosemary, and lavender will be blended with the texture of de-petaled sunflower centers. A delicate cluster of champagne grapes will be added to incorporate the winery theme of the reception. The bouquet will be accented by loops of grapevine and a wrapping of supple grapevine around the stems of the bouquet.

Price: \$69.73

GROOMSMENS' BOUTONNIERES

For his Groomsmen, Mickey may consider one of the following options which correspond to the selections proposed for the Bridesmaids:

Option One

A boutonniere designed from a mini-calla in a coppery rust tone complemented by sprigs of fresh rosemary. The boutonnieres will be finished a banding of complementary double-faced satin ribbon anchored by a pearl bead or silver wire bullion.

Price: \$14.75

Option Two

A boutonniere designed in a composite style blending a purple Curiosa rose with a chocolate cosmos bloom and green hydrangea florets finished with a banding of ribbon in a complementary color anchored by a banding of copper or bronze bullion.

Price: \$15.30

Option Three

A boutonniere designed in a composite style blending rosemary, lavender and hypericum berries accented with a loop of grapevine and finished with a banding of ribbon in a complementary color.

Price: \$13.07

CORSAGES FOR THE MOTHERS

Minnie and Mickey may select for their mothers one of the following corsage designs:

Option One

A corsage designed in a composite style blending a cream or soft plum cymbidium orchid bloom accented with florets of green hydrangea and hypericum berry. The corsage may be finished with a simple "package" style bow of lustrous double-faced satin ribbon. If the design is a wristlet corsage, the corsage may be designed without the use of ribbon if so preferred.

Price: \$21.56

Option Two

A corsage blending a mini-calla bloom in cream, cream with a deep purple throat, or a warm coppery rust tone accented by a few small tucks of tuberose or ornithagalum florets and rosemary. The corsage will be completed with a bow of organza or double-faced satin bridal ribbon.

Price: \$19.13

Either corsage style may be designed as a wristlet or pin-on style corsage and may be adjusted in color to complement the gown/attire of the wearer or the wedding palette.

CORSAGES FOR THE GRANDMOTHERS AND ANY HONORED GUESTS

The Grandmothers will receive corsages designed in a composite style blending one rose bloom selected from one of the following varieties: Vendela (cream), Leonidas (warm bronzey gold), or Curiosa (purple), accented by rosemary, lavender, and hypericum berries. A simple ribbon of a delicate organza or a wider double-faced satin may add an elegant and colorful finishing touch. The corsages may be designed as pin-on or wristlets. The selection of flowers may be adjusted to complement the gown/attire of the wearer or it may be designed to complement the wedding palette.

Price: \$15.38

BOUTONNIERES FOR THE FATHERS OF THE BRIDE AND GROOM

The Fathers may receive one of the following boutonniere designs:

Option One

A boutonniere blending a mini-cymbidium bloom accented by a green hydrangea and finished with a banding of complementary ribbon or Eurowire bullion in copper or bronze.

Price: \$14.58

Option Two

A boutonniere designed from a mini-calla bloom in cream, cream with a purple throat or coppery bronze accented by tuberose or ornithogalum florets and finished with a banding of complementary ribbon finished with silver Eurowire bullion.

Price: \$15.19

BOUTONNIERE FOR THE GRANDFATHER

The grandfather will receive boutonnieres designed from an open rose bloom in cream (Vendela), purple (Curiosa) or warm gold (Leonidas) based on the Bride's selection. The boutonniere will be finished with an accent of rosemary and hypericum and a banding of complementary ribbon anchored by silver Eurowire bullion.

Price: \$10.25

ITEMS FOR THE CEREMONY

Markers for Reserved Seating

The seating for the ceremony may be decorated with one of the following pew marker options:

Option One

Simple, rustic grapevine wreaths accented by tucks of fresh lavender and rosemary will feature clusters of champagne grapes. For a modern accent, delicate threads of coppery or bronze-toned metallic wire may be lightly interwoven with the wreath form. This design can alternately be designed as a grapevine orb topped with draping clusters of grapes suspended by a ribbon or raffia tie.

Price per pew: \$17.00

Option Two

Swags of herbs including rosemary, lavender, and sage interwoven with accents of grapevine may be tied on the pews with a rustic wrap of natural or green raffia.

Price: \$19.50

Option Three

A small “tussie-mussie” of green hydrangea, a grape cluster, a sunflower center, and Curiosa roses accented by draping ribbon, loops of grapevine and foliage may also be used to accented the guests’ seating.

Price: \$23.50

If a signature ribbon is selected for use throughout the wedding, it may also be successfully incorporated in any of the pew designs.

Altar Flowers

The Altar may be complemented with a bouquet of lush garden flowers accenting the wedding palette. Featuring Curiosa and Leonidas roses, green or cream hydrangea, French tulips, bouvardia, and bells of Ireland, the bouquet will incorporate the winery theme with the inclusion of bands of grapevine. Draping foliage will add dimension and texture while loops of deep wine aspidistra will add a modern touch of color. The design will be created to comply with the church’s guidelines.

Price: \$165.00

Dressing for the Side Stairs

To designate the side stairs, a simple dressing of ribbon in cream, a blend of shades selected by the Bride or a signature ribbon selected for use throughout the wedding, may be used with simple tucks of draping foliage. *Price per bow:\$10*

FLOWERS FOR THE RECEPTION HALL

FLOWERS FOR THE ENTRY

As a dramatic focal point in The Royal foyer, a grouping of wine bottles (approximately 6-7 bottles) featuring singular “specimen” style presentations of flowers used throughout the ceremony and reception may be displayed accented by low votives in either glass containers or hollowed fruits.

Price for wine bottle display, designs and candles: \$89.00

FLOWERS FOR THE GUESTS' TABLES

For their Guests' tables, Minnie and Mickey may consider one of the following options or a combination of several of the designs as shown in one of the budget scenarios.

Option One

Topping a tall glass cylinder vase filled with clusters of grapes suspended on grapevine or a singular wine bottle displaying a cluster of grapes and a single flower, an explosive design of garden blooms in the colors of the wedding palette including hydrangea, Leonidas and Curiosa roses, calla lilies, rosemary, lavender and “de-petaled” sunflower centers will create a study in color and texture.

Price per design: \$123.00

Option Two

In modern plum glass cubes “labeled” with a custom wine bottle logo created for Minnie and Mickey, lush garden flowers including hydrangea, Leonidas and Curiosa roses, rosemary, lavender, and mini-callas will be designed in a low, mounded “en masse” style. Loops of grapevine and a cluster of champagne grapes will enhance the winery theme. These labels may also whimsically incorporate elements and themes from the Game of Life which will be a focal point of the evening. The English Garden's graphic designer will work with the bridal couple to create a personal and unique design.

Price per design: \$63.00

Option Three

Crates purchased from regional wineries will be scaled down to use as shallow containers for low vegetative arrangements featuring a pave of grape clusters, ornamental kale, groupings of rosemary, lavender, and sweetpeas. Tall branches of fresh birch will add drama while a base of lush green mood moss embedded with tea lights will add texture and color.

Price per design: \$88.00

Option Four

Single wine bottles selected for their fun and whimsical labels will be treated as vases featuring singular studies of flowers used throughout the ceremony and reception. These will alternate with wine bottles uplit with flameless votives. Design would probably work best with two or more per table.

Price per wine bottle floral design: \$15.00

Additional wine bottles with uplights available for \$5.00 rental which includes the cost of the light.

CAKE FLOWERS

Loose flowers selected from the wedding palette may be used for a splash of color on the cake table.

Price: \$30.00 approximately

DISPLAY OF THE BRIDE'S AND MAIDS' BOUQUETS

Using risers of wine crates, the bouquets of the bridal party will be display in plum or green toned cylinder vases featuring custom wine labels created for Minnie and Mickey. These labels may also whimsically incorporate elements and themes from the Game of Life which will be a focal point of the evening. The English Garden's graphic designer will work with the bridal couple to create a personal and unique design.
